## Highways Awards Its Largest Paving Contract

CHARLESTON—Secretary of Transportation Paul Mattox has announced the awarding of a single paving project for Corridor H in Grant and Hardy counties totaling \$34,544,899.90.

“This is the largest paving contract ever awarded by the Division and it illustrates how committed we are to completing this vital link to the eastern part of West Virginia,” stated Secretary Mattox.

The project was awarded to Kokosing Construction, Inc. of Clarksburg for 10.37 miles of paving, signing, pavement markings, guardrail installation and ground restoration from Patterson Creek Road in Grant County to South Branch Potomac River Bridge at Moorefield.

Completion of this project, anticipated in the fall of 2010, will open 34 miles of Corridor H to traffic from Forman to Wardensville.
